Member Introduction

Dawn Martin, Executive Director

- Dawn started with RCC in July 2021.
- She worked for almost 12 years as the CEO of the Pharmacy Association of Saskatchewan, and spent 16 years within the Ministry of Health prior to that. She has a strong understanding of the healthcare and non-profit governance and management that she brings to RCC in the Executive Director role. Dawn has a master's degree in Political Science (Health System Governance) and has systems, media, governance, and financial management training. She has been a patient of RCC for over 30 years so is uniquely aware of the value an integrated, co-operative health clinic can bring to patients.



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Robin McMaster, Medical Co-ordinator (September 1, 2023-August 31, 2025)

- Robin accepted the role of Medical Coordinator for RCC in 2008.
- She obtained her medical degree in 1995 and completed her Rural Medicine Residency Program in 1997. After a brief time working in Winkler, MB, she moved to Regina and joined the Regina Community Clinic in 1998. During her practice years, she was part of the Obstetrical care physicians' group, delivering babies and providing all aspects of full-service family physician care. Dr. McMaster finds it very rewarding to be able to provide 25 years of longitudinal continuity of care for patients, now spanning 3 family generations in some cases. The past several years of the pandemic have presented opportunities and challenges. The RCC is the best example of a Patient Medical Home and has been committed to a process of ongoing quality improvement.
