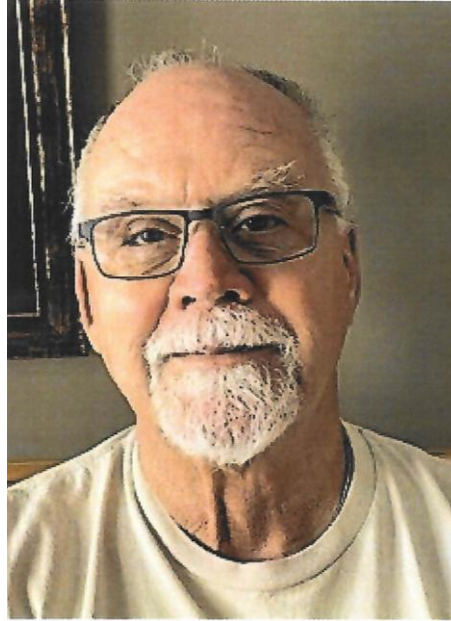


DALE RODENBUSH

Dale was 20 years as Regional Director of Pharmacy with Sun Country Health in southeastern Saskatchewan; 12 years as Assistant Director of Pharmacy, and 8 years as Staff Pharmacist, Regina General Hospital; and, casual retail pharmacist, including methadone clinic.

He was a member of the leadership team relating to accreditation, pharmaceuticals management and delivery, infection control, palliative care, community pandemics, oncology, diabetes, and acute care.



Dale directed pharmaceutical health care in both the Sun Country Health Region and the Regina General Hospital during his clinical pharmaceutical management career. Following achieving a Bachelor of Science in Pharmacy from the University of Saskatchewan and a one-year Residency program with the Regina General Hospital, Dale worked as a staff pharmacist, then as assistant director of pharmacy before assuming regional directorship with Sun Country Health in Weyburn.

Dale was team leader/chair of various subcommittees relating to accreditation, compensation, finance, pharmaceuticals and medical management and delivery in southeastern Saskatchewan. Dale also participated in steering committees for infection control, palliative care, pandemic/influenza management, community oncology, diabetes, acute care, risk management and information technology. His focus was broadly on a patients' needs first approach, quality control and enhanced pharmaceutical service.

Dale has been a negotiator for both SAHO and Saskatchewan Health Sciences, on the board of the Pharmaceutical Association of Saskatchewan for five years, and held professional memberships with the Saskatchewan College of Pharmacists, the Canadian Society of Hospital Pharmacists, and the Pharmaceutical Association of Saskatchewan throughout his career.
